FVCPAA Scholarship Program Guidelines & Procedures

Thank you for agreeing to participate once again in our scholarship program. We appreciate your involvement and have a great respect for your dedication to your students.

In order to continue to offer scholarships we must meet the standards of CPAEF. It is required that we receive at least three candidates from each University to be included in the Scholarship program. Our Scholarship Committee will make the final choice.

Please search your database and send out our Scholarship documentation to all eligible accounting students.

One scholarship is awarded to a student from each of the **three participating institutions**:

- Kwantlen Polytechnic University
- Trinity Western University
- University of the Fraser Valley

- Application deadline:** Feb 28, 2020 Students to submit their application to their university's professor for consideration.
- Short List deadline:** March 16, 2020 Professors from each university to provide a shortlist of 3 students for the FVCPAA Scholarship Committee. If there are less than 3 candidates – the scholarship will be awarded to another university. It may be helpful to scan your database for fourth year accounting students and send the application directly to them.
- Winners announced:** March 31, 2020 FVCPAA to announce winners of scholarship to each university
- Presentation of Awards:** May 7, 2020 Scholarships to be awarded to the students at the May breakfast meeting for the FVCPAA.

Qualifications

- Applicants must maintain a high-grade point average and participate in significant volunteer work.
- Must have completed 3rd year of accounting program and registered for 4th year and must plan to enter CPA program.
- Applicants must present confirmation of their plan to enter the CPA program by their references, university professor and possible future employer (if available).
- Applicants who have won a previous year scholarship cannot enter again for another possible scholarship. The FVCPAA has a commitment within their scholarship funding limitations to support as many candidates as possible.
- Applicants who win a scholarship but then do not proceed with their CPA agree to refund the scholarship amount within a 12-month period of having received the funds to enable another future candidate that will pursue the CPA program to be a possible recipient of the scholarship. Scholarships awarded by the FVCPAA are solely for the purpose of supporting candidates entering the CPA program.
- Completed application form.
- Provide two letters of reference.
